There are numerous paths around Thornhill. Look out for signposted paths around the North and South Commons, and to the south of the village along the Hedges Path and paths to Norrieston.

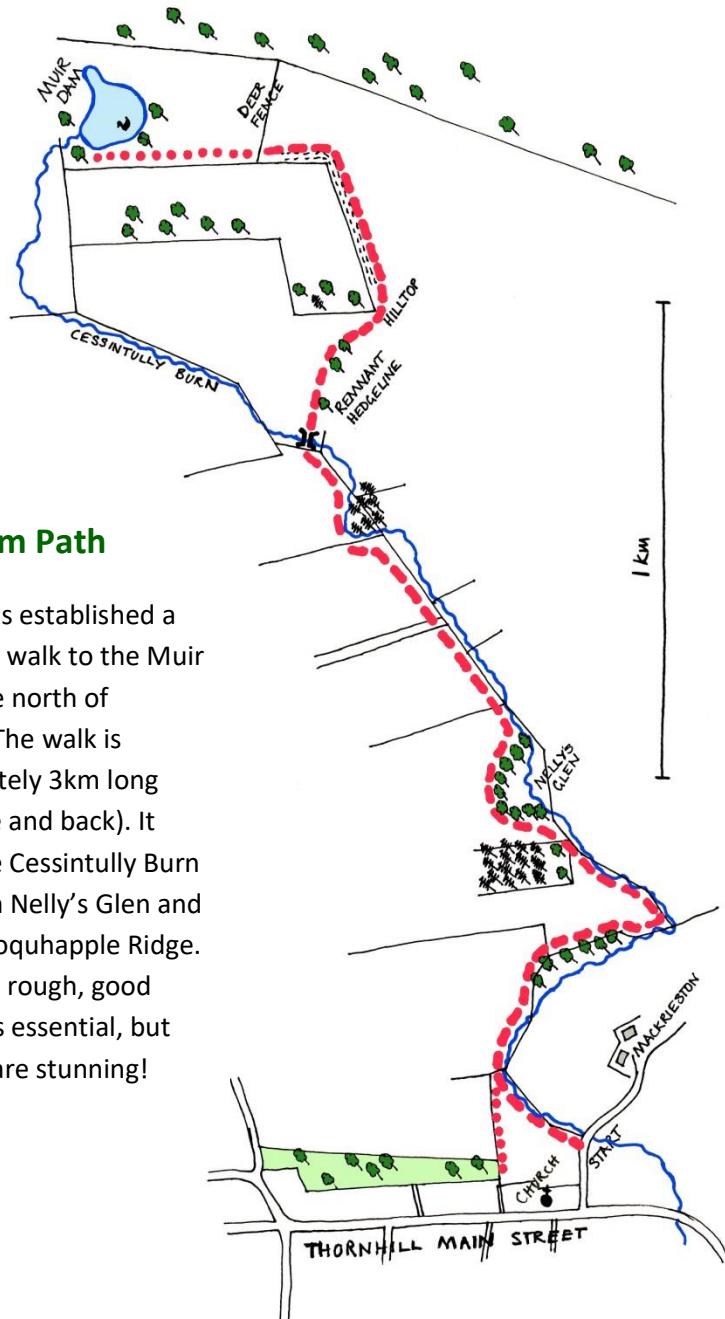

## Muir Dam Path

The TCT has established a signposted walk to the Muir Dam to the north of Thornhill. The walk is approximately 3km long (6km there and back). It follows the Cessintully Burn up through Nelly's Glen and over the Boquhapple Ridge. The path is rough, good footwear is essential, but the views are stunning!
