



Thornhill Community Trust (TCT) Charitable aims

1. Improve quality of life by providing a framework for community development in Thornhill and its environs
2. to preserve, restore and improve the environment through the provision, maintenance and/or improvement of public open space and other public amenities and other environmental and townscape regeneration projects
3. to provide within the Operating Area facilities for recreation and other leisure time occupation available to the public at large with a view to improving their conditions of life
4. to promote, establish and operate other schemes of a charitable nature for the benefit of the community

TCT Trustees

Trustees are members who take a lead in TCT by:

- maintaining an overview of the TCT's activities to ensure the aims of the trust are fulfilled
- managing the trust's finances and responsibilities as a charity
- reporting to the trustees meetings about the groups they are involved in
- supporting TCT events and activities
- creating links with other communities
- ensuring volunteers and those attending events are safe and well-treated

Trustees have equal, collective responsibility for these duties. Trustee meetings are held every 6 – 8 weeks.

TCT Members

Members can get involved to whatever level suits them, which can include:

- getting involved with active project groups (e.g. paths, biodiversity, Thornhill Views, village tubs)
- attending TCT events and activities
- volunteering at the activities arranged by the TCT groups
- generating new ideas and getting involved with setting up new projects in the village which are supported by TCT e.g. Thornhill Futures, Light Up Thornhill
- attending and voting at members meetings and the AGM
